(A) is used before singular words that start with a consonant sound and refers to non-specific things.	(An) is used before singular words that start with a vowel sound and refers to non-specific things.	(The) is used either before singular or plural words and is used to refer to specific things or something that has already been mentioned.
<ul> <li>A is also called an indefinite article</li> <li>A consonant is letter in the alphabet that is not considered a vowel</li> <li>A can only be used with countable nouns</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>An is also called an indefinite article</li> <li>A vowel is letter in the alphabet that is either (a, e, i, o, u)</li> <li>An can only be used with countable nouns</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>The is also called the definite article</li> <li>The can be used infront of a word that starts with a consonant or vowel</li> <li>The can be used with both countable and uncountable nouns</li> </ul>

Incorrect: We stayed in hotel that was close to beach.


Correct: We stayed in a hotel that was close to the beach.











