What is an Adjective?

- Adjective is a word that **describes a noun or a pronoun**.
- It tells us **how someone or something looks, feels, sounds, tastes, or behaves**.
- Adjectives help us: describe people, animals, and things, compare things, give more details, make sentences interesting and clearer.

Types of Adjectives

| Type of Adjective | What It Shows | Examples |
|-------------------------|------------------------|----------------------|
| Adjective of Quality | kind, brave, smart | a brave boy |
| Adjective of Quantity | amount (not countable) | some water |
| Adjective of Number | how many | two pencils |
| Demonstrative Adjective | points out | this book |
| Possessive Adjective | shows ownership | my bag |
| Interrogative Adjective | asks a question | which colour? |
| Adjective of Size | big/small | a small cat |
| Adjective of Shape | round/square | a round ball |
| Adjective of Colour | colours | a red apple |
| Proper Adjective | from proper nouns | American car |
| Comparative Adjective | compares two | bigger than |
| Superlative Adjective | compares three+ | the biggest |
