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## What is an Adjective?

- Adjective is a word that **describes a noun or a pronoun**.
- It tells us **how someone or something looks, feels, sounds, tastes, or behaves**.
- Adjectives help us: describe people, animals, and things, compare things, give more details, make sentences interesting and clearer.

## Types of Adjectives

<b>Possessive Adjective</b>	shows ownership	<b>my</b> bag
<b>Interrogative Adjective</b>	asks a question	<b>which</b> colour?
<b>Adjective of Size</b>	big/small	a <b>small</b> cat
<b>Adjective of Shape</b>	round/square	a <b>round</b> ball
<b>Adjective of Colour</b>	colours	a <b>red</b> apple
