What Are Adverbs of Time?

- Adverbs of time tell **when, how often, or for how long** something happens.
- They help us understand **the timing of an action** — past, present, or future.

Adverb of Time Examples Table

Type	Examples	Usage in Sentence
When	today, tomorrow, yesterday, now, later	I'll visit you tomorrow .
How Often	always, never, often, rarely, sometimes	She always studies in the morning.
How Long	still, yet, already, since, for, until	We haven't met since last summer.

Example:

- I will call you tomorrow.
- She always wakes up early.
- They worked yesterday.

Remember

- They usually answer when, how often, or how long.
- They can come at the beginning or end of a sentence.
- Common clues: today, tomorrow, yesterday, now, soon, later, again, always, never, often, sometimes.
- Adverbs of time can modify verbs, adjectives, or entire sentences.
