1. What is a Conjunction? (Definition)

A Conjunction is a "**Joining Word**." It works like a bridge to connect two words or two short sentences together.

- **Example:** I like tea. I like coffee. = I like tea and coffee.



2. The Powerful Three: And, But, Or

Word	Function (What it does)	Example
AND	Adds similar things or ideas together.	I have a bat and a ball.
BUT	Joins two different or opposite ideas.	It is small but very strong.
OR	Shows a choice between two things.	Do you want milk or juice?

3. Smart Rules for Class 2

- Use **AND** when you want to say "both" (+).
- Use **BUT** when the second part is a "surprise" (+/-).
- Use **OR** when you have to "pick one" (?).
