



What Is the Correct Form of a Verb?

- Every verb changes its form depending on tense (time), subject (who), or number (one/many).
- Using the correct form of the verb helps make sentences clear and grammatically right.

Common Verb Forms

Base Form	Past Form	Past Participle	-ing Form
go	went	gone	going
write	wrote	written	writing
eat	ate	eaten	eating
sing	sang	sung	singing
run	ran	run	running

Remember

- The base form is used with I, you, we, they.
- They play cricket.
- Add -s / -es with he, she, it.
- F He plays cricket.
- Use was / were for past continuous.
- 🗲 I was reading. / They were reading.
- Use has / have / had + past participle for perfect tenses.
- F She has gone home. / We had finished lunch.
- Use is / am / are + -ing form for actions happening now.
- He is eating breakfast.

Examples:

- She **plays** the piano every day. (Present tense singular subject)
- They **play** the piano every day. (Present tense plural subject)
- He **played** football yesterday. (Past tense)
- We are **playing** now. (Present continuous)
