 **Instruction:** How to use demonstrative pronouns

We use This and That to point out things.

- They are called demonstrative words – words that show which thing we are talking about.

	Near	Far
Singular	This	That
Plural	These	Those

How to Use "This"

- We use This for one thing (singular) that is near us.
- "This" means something you can touch or that is close to you.

Examples:

- This is my pencil.
- This is a ball.
- This is my book.
- This is an apple.

Tip for Parents:

- Ask your child to hold any object (like a toy) and say – "This is my toy."

How to Use "That"

- We use That for one thing (singular) that is far from us.
- "That" means something you can see but not touch easily because it's away.

Examples:

- That is a tree.
- That is a car on the road.
- That is a bird in the sky.
- That is my school.

Tip for Parents:

- Point at an object that's far away, like a tree or a fan, and say – "That is a tree."
