1. What is the Future Tense?

The Future Tense is used to express actions, events, or states that have not happened yet but are expected to occur after the present moment.

2. The 4 Forms of Future Tense

Tense Form	Main Usage	Formula / Structure	Example Sentence
Simple Future	Unplanned decisions, promises, predictions	Subject + will/shall + Base Verb + Object (or: am/is/are + going to + Base Verb)	She will travel to London tomorrow.
Future Continuous	Actions continuing at a specific time in future	Subject + will be + Verb-ing + Object	They will be playing cricket at 5 PM.
Future Perfect	Action that will be completed before a point in future	Subject + will have + Verb(3rd form) + Object	I will have finished my project by Monday.
Future Perfect Continuous	Action ongoing up to a specific time in future	Subject + will have been + Verb-ing + Object + for/since	He will have been working here for 5 years by 2027.

3. "Will" vs. "Going to" (Key Difference)

Will: Quick decisions, promises, offers, or opinions.

- I am tired. I will sleep now.
- I promise I will call you.

Be Going to: Planned actions, intentions, or visible evidence.

- We are going to buy a car next week. (Plan)
- Look at those dark clouds! It is going to rain. (Evidence)

5. Common Rules & Mistakes

Base Verb Rule: Always use the pure base verb after will or won't.

- **Wrong:** She will goes tomorrow.
- **Right:** She will go tomorrow.

Negative Sentences:

- will not shortens to won't.
- am/is/are not going to.

4. Signal Words (Clues)

- Everyday Future Clues: tomorrow, next week/month/year, soon, later, in 2 days
- Future Perfect Clues: by the time, by tomorrow, by 2028, before
- Opinion Words (often with 'will'): I think, I hope, probably, definitely
