What is a Noun?

- A noun is the name of a person, place, animal, or thing.
- It tells who or what we are talking about.

Examples:

- Riya, school, cat, apple, India, book

Example Sentences:

- **Riya** is reading a **book**.
- The **dog** is barking loudly.
- We live in **India**.

What is a Pronoun?

- A pronoun is a word used in place of a noun to avoid repeating the same name again and again.

Examples:

- I, he, she, it, we, they, you, me, him, her

Example Sentences:

- **Riya** is my friend. **She** is very kind.
- **Rahul and I** are going to the park. **We** love to play there.
- The **dog** is hungry. **It** wants food.

Relative Pronouns Table

Point	Noun	Pronoun
Meaning	Names a person, place, animal, or thing	Replaces a noun to avoid repetition
Example Words	Riya, school, apple, cat	I, he, she, it, we, they
Used For	Introducing names	Referring back to nouns
Example Sentence	Riya is a good dancer.	She is a good dancer.

Why Do We Use Pronouns?

- To make sentences shorter and clearer
- To avoid repeating the same word
- To improve the flow of writing

Example:

- **Without pronoun:** Riya loves Riya's cat because Riya plays with Riya's cat.
- **With pronoun:** Riya loves her cat because she plays with it.

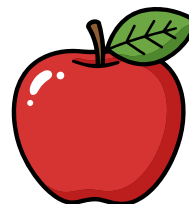
