What Are Parts of Speech?

- Every word we use in a sentence has a special job. These jobs are called **Parts of Speech**.
- There are **eight main parts of speech** in English grammar. Each part helps us understand how words work together to make clear and meaningful sentences.

The 8 Parts of Speech Table

Part of Speech	Definition (Simple)	Example Words	Example Sentence
1. Noun	Names a person, place, thing, or idea	boy, park, book, happiness	The boy is reading a book .
2. Pronoun	Replaces a noun to avoid repetition	he, she, it, they	She is playing in the garden.
3. Verb	Shows action or state of being	run, eat, is, are	The birds fly in the sky.
4. Adjective	Describes a noun or pronoun	tall, beautiful, red, big	It is a beautiful flower.
5. Adverb	Describes a verb, adjective, or another	quickly, very, well, yesterday	He runs quickly .
6. Preposition	Shows relationship between	on, under, in, beside	The cat is under the table.
7. Conjunction	Joins words, phrases, or sentences	and, but, because, or	I like apples and bananas.
8. Interjection	Shows sudden feeling or emotion	wow, oh, hey, ouch	Wow! That's amazing!
