# What Are Phrasal Verbs?

• A phrasal verb is made up of a main verb + one or more particles (a preposition or adverb) that completely change the verb's meaning.

### Structure of a Phrasal Verb


Main Verb	Particle	New Meaning	Example
look	after	take care of	She looks after her sister.
give	up	stop doing something	He gave up smoking.
turn	on	start something	Please turn on the fan.
bring	up	raise (a child or topic)	They brought up an interesting idea.
call	off	cancel	The match was called off due to rain.

#### Remember:

- The particle (up, on, off, after, out, etc.) changes the meaning of the verb.
- Some phrasal verbs are separable you can put the object in between.
- Turn off the TV. / Turn the TV off.
- Some are inseparable you cannot separate them.
- Look after your sister. (X Look your sister after)
- The same verb can form different meanings with different particles.
- take off (remove), take up (start), take in (understand)

### **Examples:**

- She looked after her little brother. (take care of)
- Please turn off the lights before you leave. (switch off)
- The plane took off on time. (began flying)
