What is a Possessive Adjective?

- A **possessive adjective** is a word used **before a noun** to show **ownership** or **possession**.
- It tells **who the noun belongs to**.

Example:

- This is **my** bag.
- That is **your** pen.
- He lost **his** wallet.

List of Possessive Adjectives

Person	Singular	Plural
1st Person	my	our
2nd Person	your	your
3rd Person	his / her / its	their

Difference Between Possessive Adjectives and Possessive Pronouns

Possessive Adjective	Possessive Pronoun
my, your, his, her, its, our, their	mine, yours, his, hers, its, ours, theirs
Always comes before a noun	Replaces a noun
Example: This is my bag.	Example: This bag is mine .

Examples:

- This is my book. → (possessive adjective)
- This book is mine. → (possessive pronoun)
