### **₩** What is a Possessive Adjective?

- A possessive adjective is a word used before a noun to show ownership or possession.
- It tells who the noun belongs to.

#### **Example:**

- This is my bag.
- That is your pen.
- He lost his wallet.

### **List of Possessive Adjectives**

Person	Singular	Plural
1st Person	my	our
2nd Person	your	your
3rd Person	his / her / its	their

### Difference Between Possessive Adjectives and Possessive Pronouns

Possessive Adjective	Possessive Pronoun		
my, your, his, her, its, our, their	mine, yours, his, hers, its, ours, theirs		
Always comes <b>before</b> a noun	Replaces a noun		
Example: This is <b>my</b> bag.	Example: This bag is <b>mine</b> .		

#### **Examples:**

- This is my book. → (possessive adjective)
- This book is mine. → (possessive pronoun)
