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What is a Possessive Pronoun?

A **possessive pronoun** is a word that shows **ownership or possession**.
It tells us **who something belongs** to without repeating the noun again.

List of Possessive Pronouns

Person	Singular	Plural
1st Person	mine	ours
2nd Person	yours	yours
3rd Person	his / hers / its	theirs

Examples:

- This book is mine. (It belongs to me.)
- That pen is yours. (It belongs to you.)
- The red car is his. (It belongs to him.)
- The yellow bag is hers. (It belongs to her.)
- The cat hurt its paw. (The paw belongs to the cat.)
- These shoes are ours. (They belong to us.)
- The toys are theirs. (They belong to them.)

Remember

- ✓ A possessive pronoun replaces a noun phrase showing possession.
- ✗ Don't confuse it with possessive adjectives (my, your, his, her, our, their).

Examples:

- This is my book. → (possessive adjective)
- This book is mine. → (possessive pronoun)
