We use the Present Perfect Continuous tense when talking about actions that started in the past and are still happening or have just stopped.

POSITIVE	NEGATIVE	QUESTION
I have been eating. You have been eating. We have been eating. They have been eating. He has been eating. She has been eating. It has been eating.	I haven't been eating. You haven't been eating.
