What is a Pronoun?

- A Pronoun is a word that is used in place of a noun to avoid repetition.
- It makes sentences shorter, clearer, and more natural.

Example: Instead of saying – Riya is a good girl. Riya likes to dance. We say – Riya is a good girl. She likes to dance.

Types of Pronouns with Examples

Type of Pronoun	Definition	Examples in Sentence		
1. Personal Pronoun	Refers to a person or thing.	I, you, he, she, it, we, they — She is my friend.		
2. Possessive Pronoun	Shows ownership or possession.	mine, yours, his, hers, ours, theirs — This book is mine.		
3. Reflexive Pronoun	Refers back to the subject itself.	myself, yourself, himself, herself, itself, ourselves, themselves — He hurt himself.		
4. Demonstrative Pronoun	Points out specific things or people.	this, that, these, those — These are my shoes.		
5. Interrogative Pronoun	Used to ask questions.	who, whom, whose, which, what — Who is knocking at the door?		
6. Relative Pronoun	Connects a clause or phrase to a noun or pronoun.	who, whom, whose, which, that — The boy who won is my brother.		
7. Indefinite Pronoun	Refers to people or things in general.	someone, anyone, everyone, something, nothing — Someone is waiting outside.		
8. Reciprocal Pronoun	Shows mutual action or feeling.	each other, one another — They helped each other.		
9. Emphatic Pronoun	Used to emphasize a noun or pronoun.	myself, yourself, himself, herself, itself — I myself cleaned the room.
