What is a Pronoun?

- A Pronoun is a word that is used in place of a noun to avoid repetition.
- It makes sentences shorter, clearer, and more natural.

Example: Instead of saying – Riya is a good girl. Riya likes to dance.
We say – Riya is a good girl. She likes to dance.

Types of Pronouns with Examples

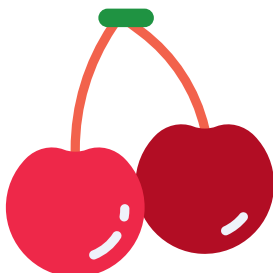
Type of Pronoun	Definition	Examples in Sentence
1. Personal Pronoun	Refers to a person or thing.	I, you, he, she, it, we, they – She is my friend.
2. Possessive Pronoun	Shows ownership or possession.	mine, yours, his, hers, ours, theirs – This book is mine.
3. Reflexive Pronoun	Refers back to the subject itself.	myself, yourself, himself, herself, itself, ourselves, themselves – He hurt himself.
4. Demonstrative Pronoun	Points out specific things or people.	this, that, these, those – These are my shoes.
5. Interrogative Pronoun	Used to ask questions.	who, whom, whose, which, what – Who is knocking at the door?
6. Relative Pronoun	Connects a clause or phrase to a noun or pronoun.	who, whom, whose, which, that – The boy who won is my brother.
7. Indefinite Pronoun	Refers to people or things in general.	someone, anyone, everyone, something, nothing – Someone is waiting outside.
8. Reciprocal Pronoun	Shows mutual action or feeling.	each other, one another – They helped each other.
9. Emphatic Pronoun	Used to emphasize a noun or pronoun.	myself, yourself, himself, herself, itself – I myself cleaned the room.

Types of Pronouns	Person	Singular	Plural
	1st Person	I, me, mine, myself	we, us, ours, ourselves
	2nd Person	you, yours, yourself	you, yours, yourselves
	3rd Person	he, she, it, him, her, his, hers, itself	they, them, theirs, themselves

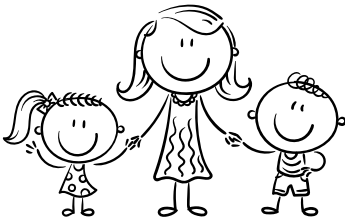

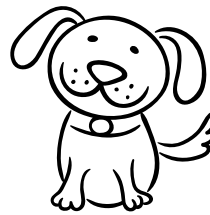

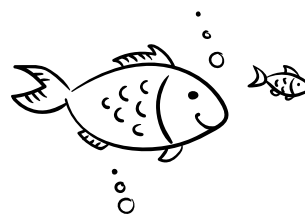
