1. What is the Simple Future Tense?

The Simple Future Tense talks about actions that have not happened yet, but will happen later (in the future).

2. Sentence Structure & Rules

Sentence Type	Formula / Rule	Example
Positive (+)	Subject + will + Base Verb (V1)	I will play cricket tomorrow.
Negative (-)	Subject + will not (won't) + Base Verb (V1)	She won't eat junk food.
Question (?)	Will + Subject + Base Verb (V1) + ?	Will they visit the zoo on Sunday?

3. Two Ways to Talk About the Future

Will + Base Verb: Quick decisions, promises, and predictions without proof.

- It's cold outside. I will wear my jacket. (Sudden decision)
- I promise I will return your book. (Promise)

Be (am / is / are) + going to + Base Verb: Plans already made or things about to happen based on clear clues.

- We are going to travel to Goa next week. (Fixed plan)
- Look at those black clouds! It is going to rain. (Clear clue)

4. Golden Rule (Never Make This Mistake!)

- ✗ Wrong: She will plays. / He will went. / They will playing.
- ✓ Right: She will play. / He will go. / They will play.

5. Time Clues (Signal Words)

If these words appear in a sentence, the Simple Future Tense is used:

- Tomorrow / Tomorrow morning
- Next week / Next month / Next year / Next Sunday
- Soon / Later / In two days / Tonight

6. Quick Practice Examples:

- Riya will paint a picture tomorrow. (Positive)
- We will not forget your birthday. (Negative)
- Will you help me carry this bag? (Question)
- The children will visit the science museum next Monday. (Positive)
- He won't go outside because it is raining heavily. (Negative)



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We use the Future Simple Tense when talking about actions that will happen in the future.

POSITIVE	NEGATIVE	QUESTION
I will eat. You will eat. We will eat. They will eat. He will eat. She will eat. It will eat.	I won't eat. You won't eat. We won't eat. They won't eat. He won't eat. She won't eat. It won't eat.	Will I eat? Will you eat? Will we eat? Will they eat? Will he eat? Will she eat? Will it eat?
