 **Instruction:** Singular And Plural – Grammar Cheatsheet for Kids

 What are Singular and Plural Nouns?

- A Singular Noun means one person, place, animal, or thing.
- A Plural Noun means more than one person, place, animal, or thing.

Type	Singular	Plural	Example Sentence
Common noun	boy	boys	One boy is playing. / Two boys are playing.
Animal	cat	cats	The cat is sleeping. / The cats are sleeping.
Object	car	cars	I have one car. / We have two cars.
Place	park	parks	The park is clean. / The parks are clean.
Irregular	child	children	The child is happy. / The children are happy.

How to Make Plural Nouns – Easy Rules

- Add -s to most nouns : book → books,
- Add -es to nouns ending with s, sh, ch, x, o: bus → buses
- If noun ends in y (after a consonant), change y → ies: baby → babies
- If noun ends in y (after a vowel), just add s: toy → toys
- If noun ends in f or fe, change to ves: leaf → leaves
- Some words change completely : man → men
- Some nouns stay the same : sheep → sheep, deer → deer
- Some nouns are always plural : scissors, trousers, glasses

 Quick Tips for Students:

- “One” → use singular word
- “Two or more” → use plural word
- Check the last letter of the word – it helps decide how to change it!
- Remember: Irregular plurals don’t follow normal rules – you must memorize them.
