1. What is an Interjection? (Definition)

Tenses show the time when an action happens. There are three main types of time: Past (yesterday), Present (today), and Future (tomorrow). Each type has four different forms.

- **Present Tense:** Talks about actions happening right now, regular habits, or universal truths.
- **Past Tense:** Talks about actions that already finished in the time before now.
- **Future Tense:** Talks about actions that will happen later in the time to come.

2. The Master Tense Table

- This table explains all 12 tenses using the base verb "play" with the subject "I" or "He/She" to show how the structure changes.

Tense Form	Present Tense	Past Tense	Future Tense
Simple	I play football daily. / He plays football.	I played football yesterday.	I will play football tomorrow.
Continuous	I am playing football now. / He is playing .	I was playing football when it rained.	I will be playing football at this time.
Perfect	I have played football already. / He has played .	I had played football before night.	I will have played football by noon.
Perfect Continuous	I have been playing football for an hour.	I had been playing football before the bell rang.	I will have been playing football since morning.

3. Quick Structure Formulas

Simple Forms:

- Simple Present: Subject + Verb (s/es)
- Simple Past: Subject + Verb (2nd form)
- Simple Future: Subject + Will + Verb (1st form)

Continuous Forms:

- Present Continuous: Subject + Is/Am/Are + Verb-ing
- Past Continuous: Subject + Was/Were + Verb-ing
- Future Continuous: Subject + Will be + Verb-ing

Perfect Forms:

- Present Perfect: Subject + Has/Have + Verb (3rd form)
- Past Perfect: Subject + Had + Verb (3rd form)
- Future Perfect: Subject + Will have + Verb (3rd form)

Perfect Continuous Forms:

- Present Perfect Continuous: Subject + Has/Have + Been + Verb-ing
- Past Perfect Continuous: Subject + Had + Been + Verb-ing
- Future Perfect Continuous: Subject + Will have + Been + Verb-ing
