

Instruction: "Was" and "Were" are past tense forms of the verb "to be."

We use them to talk about things that happened yesterday, last week, or in the past.

Subject Type	Use	Examples
<b>Singular</b> (one person or thing)	Was	I <b>was</b> at school yesterday. He <b>was</b> my best friend. She <b>was</b> happy.
<b>Plural</b> (more than one person or thing)	Were	We <b>were</b> in the park. They <b>were</b> playing football. You <b>were</b> very kind.

# When to Use "Was"

We use "was" with singular subjects (only one person or thing):

🗲 I, he, she, it, this, that

#### **Examples:**

- I was at the park yesterday.
- She **was** very happy.
- It **was** a sunny day.
- He was my best friend.
- That **was** an interesting story.

### Tip for Kids:

If there is one person or thing — use was.

#### When to Use "Were"

We use "were" with plural subjects (more than one person or thing):

we, you, they, these, those

#### **Examples:**

- We were at school yesterday.
- They were playing football.
- You were very kind.
- Those were my old toys.
- These were beautiful flowers.

#### Tip for Kids:

If there are many people or things — use were.
